

Access TrailersTM Hire Terms and Conditions

For the purpose of this document and for the avoidance of doubt, the person or business hiring the trailer shall be known as the Hirer. Access Trailers Sales and Rentals Ltd who supply the trailer for hire will be known as the Owner of the trailer and the trailer being hired shall be known as the Trailer.

1. The Hirer shall acknowledge that the Trailer is fit for purpose and in good condition once it is delivered to the pre agreed delivery destination. The Hirer also agrees to have the Trailer ready for collection by the Owner in the same condition on the pre agreed date and time and at the pre agreed location.
2. The Hirer shall ensure that the Trailer is not used:
 - For Re-Hire
 - Any activities outside of mainland UK (England, Wales and Scotland) unless pre agreed in writing with the Owner.
 - Shall not lend, sell or otherwise part with the Trailer.
3. The Hirer agree to the following:
 - Keep the trailer secure for the duration of the hire period.
 - Inform the Owner of any damage or defects immediately.
 - To have a suitable tow vehicle rated to the relevant plated tow weight of the Trailer with a 50mm tow ball and 7 or 13 pin socket wired/fitted to international standards.
4. The Hirer shall insure, using their own insurance, all risks of loss or damage to the Trailer during the period

of hire, whilst the Trailer is attached to or detached from any vehicle.

5. The Hirer shall fully indemnify the Owner in respect of all claims by any person whomsoever, for injury to the person or property, caused by or in connection with, or arising out of the use of the Trailer.
6. The Hirer agrees to pay the Owner:
 - The rental, delivery and collection charges by either BACS or by cheque into the Owners bank. Funds must have been cleared at least 48 hours prior to the delivery date of the Trailer.
 - A cleaning charge will be incurred if at the end of the hire period the Trailer is returned dirty or in a condition worse than when it was delivered.
 - Repair costs quoted by the Trailer manufacturer for any internal/external damage to the Trailer or accessories damaged during the rental period of the Trailer or accessories lost or not returned on collection of the Trailer.
 - Cost of tyre punctures to be paid by the Hirer which occur during the hire period or the full replacement cost of a new tyre if it is not repairable.
 - The entire cost of the Trailer as listed for that model on the Access TrailersTM website should damage caused be too great for it to be repaired.
7. The minimum length of hire period is 7 days unless specified separately by the Owner. Should the Hirer not return the Trailer at the agreed time the Hirer will pay the Owner 50% of the weekly hire fee for each day over the agreed hire period.

8. The Hirer shall inform the Owner of any damage caused to the Trailer during the hire period at the earliest time.
